Green Line Train Protection and Track Upgrades
Virtual Public Meeting (via Zoom)

Wednesday May 18, 2022 at 6:00 PM

Please join the Capital Transformation team for an online public meeting to learn about **Green Line Train Protection and Track Upgrades**. This year we have four full access closures scheduled across the B, C, D, and E branches to accelerate the installation of Green Line Train Protection System (GLTPS) equipment and complete over 10,000 feet of additional track rehabilitation across the system.

Benefits:

- GLTPS combines vehicle and wayside equipment to avoid train-on-train collisions, adds red-light signal protection, and incorporates speed enforcement creating safer and more reliable service for riders
- Track renewal provides safer, more comfortable, and more reliable service for riders – reducing the risk of unplanned service disruptions

2022 Construction Schedule:

- **B Branch** (Boston College – Kenmore): June 20 - July 1
- **C Branch** (Cleveland Circle – Kenmore): July 11 - July 22
- **E Branch** (Heath St – Copley): August 6 - August 21
- **D Branch** (Riverside – Kenmore): September 24 - October 30

The meeting will begin with a presentation at 6:00 PM, followed by time for Questions and Answers.

Green Line Alternative Service (B, C, E, and D Branches)

Free shuttle buses will operate along the Green Line on the same schedule as train service.

- Shuttles are a combination of MBTA buses and private carrier buses
- All drivers are trained to assist riders and to operate lifts
- Service will be monitored throughout and adjusted to reduce crowding
- Some existing bus stop locations may shift for safety and access during construction, and signs will direct passengers to the new stop locations

B Branch: Alternative Service from Boston College to Kenmore for 12 days from June 20 - July 1



Shuttles do not stop at Warren St, Allston St, or Packards Corner Stations

Riders should use Washington St, Harvard Ave, and Babcock St stations as alternatives

C Branch: Alternative Service from Cleveland Circle to Kenmore for 12 days from July 11- July 22



Shuttles do not stop at Brandon Hall or Kent St Stations

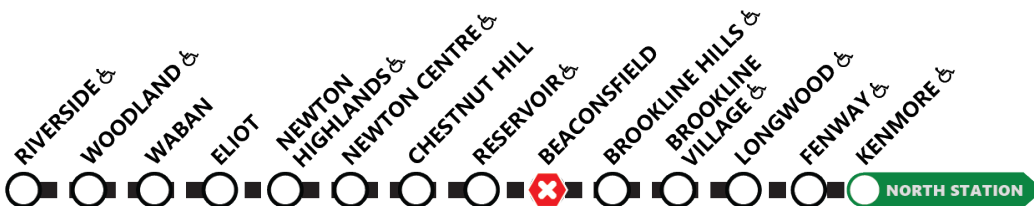
Riders should use Fairbanks St or Summit Ave and St. Paul St or Hawes St Stations as alternatives

E Branch: Alternative Service from Heath St to Copley will be provided with enhanced Rt39 Bus for 16 days from August 6 - August 21



MBTA Route 39 bus and bus stops will be enhanced to carry passengers to and from Heath St and Copley Stations

D Branch: Alternative Service from Riverside to Kenmore for three 9-day surges from September 24 - October 30



Shuttles do not stop at Beaconsfield Station

Riders should use the C branch from Dean Rd, or access the shuttle from Reservoir Station as alternatives
