Accelerating Wellington Yard Reliability Upgrades

Please join the Capital Transformation Team for an online public meeting to learn about **Accelerating Wellington Yard Reliability Upgrades**. This August we have a full access closure planned to replace over 7,000 feet of track, 4 units of special trackwork, and 2,300 feet of third rail. Capital Transformation will be replacing the tracks that connect Wellington Yard to the mainline, which requires a mainline outage. Capital Transformation is also working with other departments within the MBTA to identify additional trackwork along the Orange Line to amplify results during the 30-day period.

Benefits:

- Improved service reliability through an expanded yard and new diagnostic equipment, enabling technicians to repair Orange Line trains and return them to service more quickly
- Improved vehicle cleaning leading to a better experience for riders
- Safety and accessibility improvements for workers

The meeting will begin with a **presentation at 6:00 PM**, followed by time for Questions and Answers.

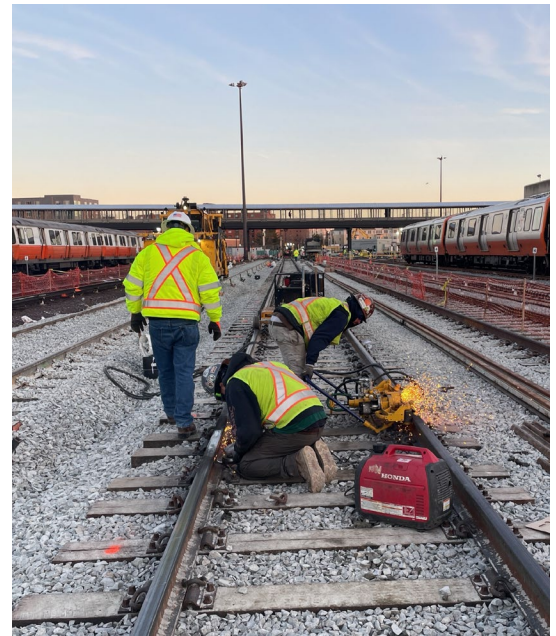

Orange Line Alternative Service

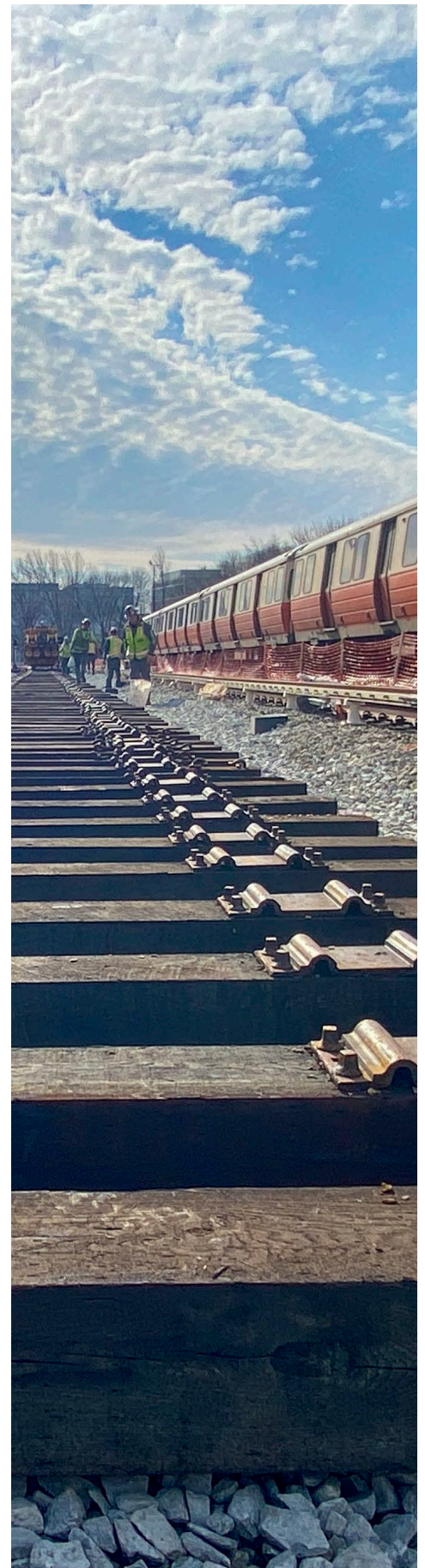
Orange Line: Alternative Service from Oak Grove to Wellington for 30 days from July 29 – August 28

Free shuttle buses will operate along the Orange Line

- Shuttle pick up and drop offs will be located at Oak Grove, Malden Center, and Wellington Stations
- Shuttle fleet will be a combination of MBTA buses and private carrier buses
- Shuttles will be accessible, and all drivers are trained to assist riders and operate lifts
- Attendants will be available at Orange Line stations throughout the diversion
- Service will be monitored throughout and adjusted as needed to reduce crowding
